Dressage Riders can qualify, by achieving 58% or more, for the Dressage Championships of Great Britain to be held at the David Broome Event Centre in Wales – horse/rider must be unaffiliated to qualify.

Dressage riders must become members of the Club if they wish to compete. However, a “Dressage Day Membership” is £3.00 EXTRA per class per show in addition to the Class entry fee of £10.00. The Dressage Secretary MUST receive your membership number OR the day membership fee at the time of entry otherwise YOUR ENTRY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

There is an extra class within each of our classes – please mark your entry if you wish to be considered for the Veteran Section (Horse 15+)

## **BARLEYFIELDS RIDING CLUB RULES**

- 1: There will be **NO REFUND OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY REASON.**
- 2: Any objections must be placed with the Secretary, in writing, accompanied by a fee of £10.00, within **FIFTEEN MINUTES** of the end of the relevant class. This fee will be returned if the objection is upheld.
- 3: See **SEPARATE SCHEDULE/ENTRY FORM FOR DRESSAGE CLASSES 5.1, 5.2, 5.3, 5.4, 5.5 AND 5.6.**
- 4: **Pony Showjumping Classes will commence at 9.00 a.m. with Clear Round followed at 9.30 with class 3.1 with Horse Showjumping classes and Clear Round (classes 5.6 to 5.9 NOT BEFORE 12 NOON.**
- 5: PRIZE MONEY to third place (according to entries, i.e. minimum of 3 entries for first prize, 6-10 entries for second prize, 11-15 entries for third prize) and rosettes to sixth.
- 6: The additional Rules pertaining to the Equestrian Life Qualification classes on 6 MAY & 10 JUNE ONLY are in the box above and should be read before entering those relevant classes which are separately shown, also in boxes.
- 7: **6 MAY AND 10 JUNE ONLY**  
Equestrian Life Qualifiers. **ENSURE YOU HAVE EQUESTRIAN LIFE REGISTRATION CARD – MUST BE CARRIED IN THE RING.**
- 8: Every effort is made to avoid classes clashing but inevitably this can happen and it is the **COMPETITORS THEMSELVES OR THEIR HELPERS** who should keep an eye on proceedings in the various rings. If you are likely to be required in another ring you should advise the Steward of the relevant ring that you are likely to be a little late.  
  
All competitors must use their own judgement on these situations and the Club cannot be held responsible.  
  
Dressage Times take precedence over the other classes and Judges will wait, provided COMPETITORS OR THEIR HELPERS advise the relevant steward accordingly. All Judges will have a list of the dressage times so will know the names of people in their classes.
- 9: **THE JUDGES' DECISIONS ARE FINAL AND BINDING AT ALL TIMES AND ANY CONFRONTATION WITH A JUDGE IN THE RING IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN.**
- 10: Please park within the designated areas.
- 11: Please ask for assistance when reversing out and be mindful of children and horses/ponies.
- 12: Health and Safety Rules must be followed at all times. All children must be supervised at all times. HORSES/PONIES MUST NOT BE TIED UP OUTSIDE OF TRAILER OR HORSEBOX. NO MUCKING OUT INTO CAR PARK.  
  
**ALL RISK ASSESSMENTS FOR SETTING UP AND RUNNING OF SHOWS ARE AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION IN THE OFFICE AT BARLEYFIELDS EQUESTRIAN CENTRE.**
- 13: Any horse/pony behaving in an unfit manner in collecting rings will be asked to leave.
